## Organization

- Design evolution and why changes were made (w/ images)  
(i.e., contextual inquiry, low-fidelity testing evidence for changes)
- Current interface description (w/ images)
  - what does it do
  - how does it work
  - what is not yet implemented
- Demo of interactive prototype (may be spread throughout)
- Summary

## Presentation

- Use slides. Ensure that the presentation shows appropriate preparation and that visual aids are effective.
- Cover the required scope within the 15 minute time period. Practice and time your presentation.
- Presenter:
  - makes eye contact
  - projects well
  - is dressed appropriately

## Representative Tasks

- Did they provide coverage of the functionality?
- Where the tasks too easy or too hard?

## User Interface

- Was the interface novel and creative?
- Was it appropriate for the supported tasks?
- Does it follow from the contextual inquiry and low-fidelity testing results?

## Presentation of Functionality

- Was enough presented to illustrate the representative tasks?
- Was enough presented to give a flavor of the interface?
- Was overall content appropriate given difficulty of interface ideas?
