Why, local sustainable agriculture?

- Did you know that 17 % of petroleum demand in the US is for the food production industry?

- Did you know that the food on your plate has traveled an average of 1500 miles to get there?

- Did you know smaller farms tend to be 2-10 times more productive than larger farms?

- Did you know that 90% of the agricultural subsidies benefit corporations and big farmers growing food for export; while 500 family farms close down every week in the United States?
- Did you know that 91 cents of each dollar spent at traditional food markets [ie: commercial] goes to suppliers, processors, middlemen, and marketers; only 9 cents of each dollar actually goes to the farmer?

Problem



- Information about sustainable foods is not easily accessible
 - People don't realize what they're putting into their bodies
 - People are not aware of the negative effects of their eating habits
- Products and prices can differ drastically across various stores
- Time, energy and money are wasted









Solution

The app would help users

- evaluate their current food purchases
- learn about some better choices when it comes to grocery shopping
- find where the best places to buy eco-conscious foods are in their area
- develop a presence in their community
- encourage the "eating local" lifestyle



Contextual Inquiry




- Description
 - Observed consumers and their grocery shopping habits
 - 8 individuals(age range: 20-50)
 - Local farmer's market(organic, sustainable products)
 - Local supermarket (mixture of sustainable products and items that were imported)

Questions

- 1.) What things do you consider when buying products at grocery stores? Where do you go to get information about these products?
- 2.) Do you shop here often? Why do you choose this store?
- 3.) How much do you know about sustainable foods? Do you know about eco-friendly eating? If so, what does it mean to you?
- 4.) Do you own a smartphone?
- 5.) What are your concerns about purchasing sustainable foods, if any?

CI Results

- All users were concerned with purchasing groceries while on a budget
- Most users preferred to purchase eco-friendly food items, but could not always do so because (1) it is not available (2) it is expensive or (3) poor quality
- Most users were concerned about the proximity of farmer's markets and grocery stores that provide sustainable, local foods
- Some participants lacked sufficient knowledge about eco-friendly products that would persuade them to purchase locally
- All of our participants answered that they would definitely use our app to compare prices and sustainability of products across stores and markets in their region.





Tasks


- Checking Information on a Product (easy)
