  - Put (upload) them to Dante





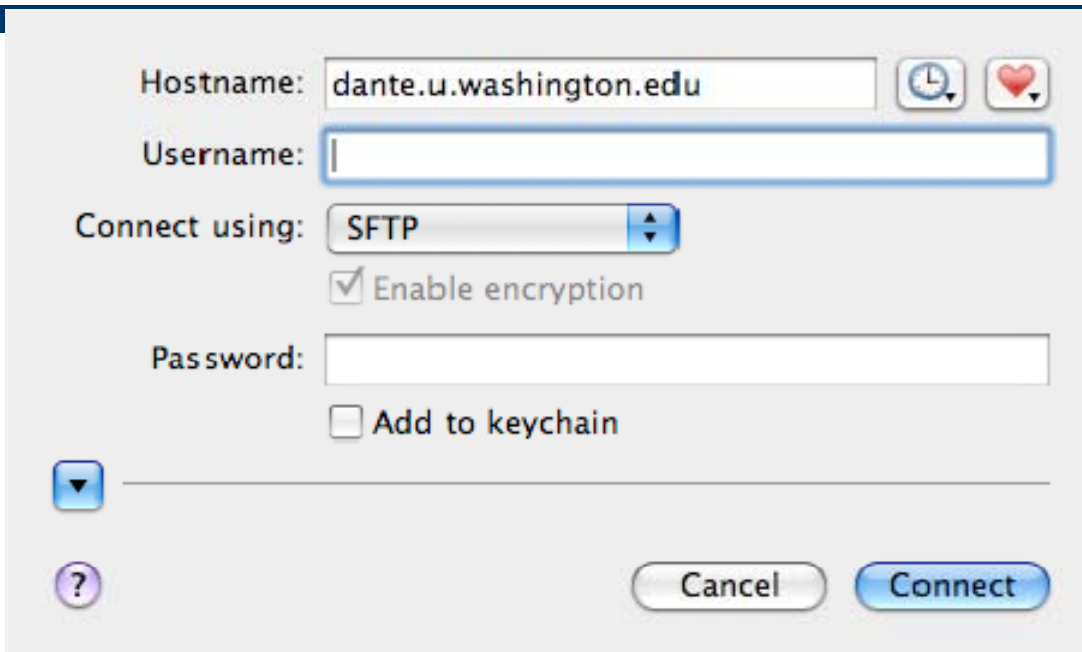
# Step 1



- Click on **FETCH**



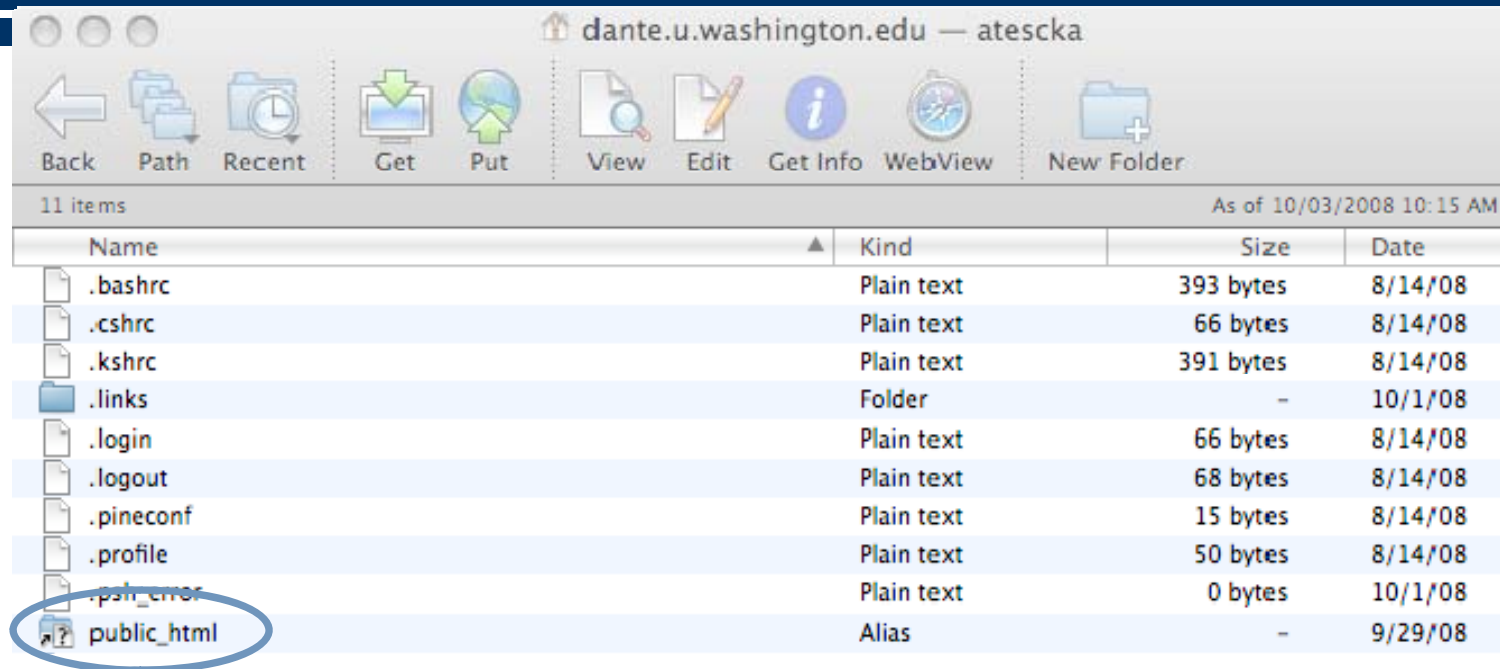
## Step 2

- Type in your UW Net ID and your password and hit Connect
- Make sure SFTP is selected on the drop-down list and “Enable Encryption” is checked



# Step 3



- Find the public\_html at the bottom of the list
- Double-click public\_html to open it
- public\_html is the shortcut to *students* Web server
- Your default home page (index.html) will be in public\_html



## Step 4

- Editing Your File

- Drag and drop your file to desktop.
- **Warning:** If you double click on the file, it opens with TextEdit—*not* what you want!
- How to open with Text Wrangler....



## Step 5

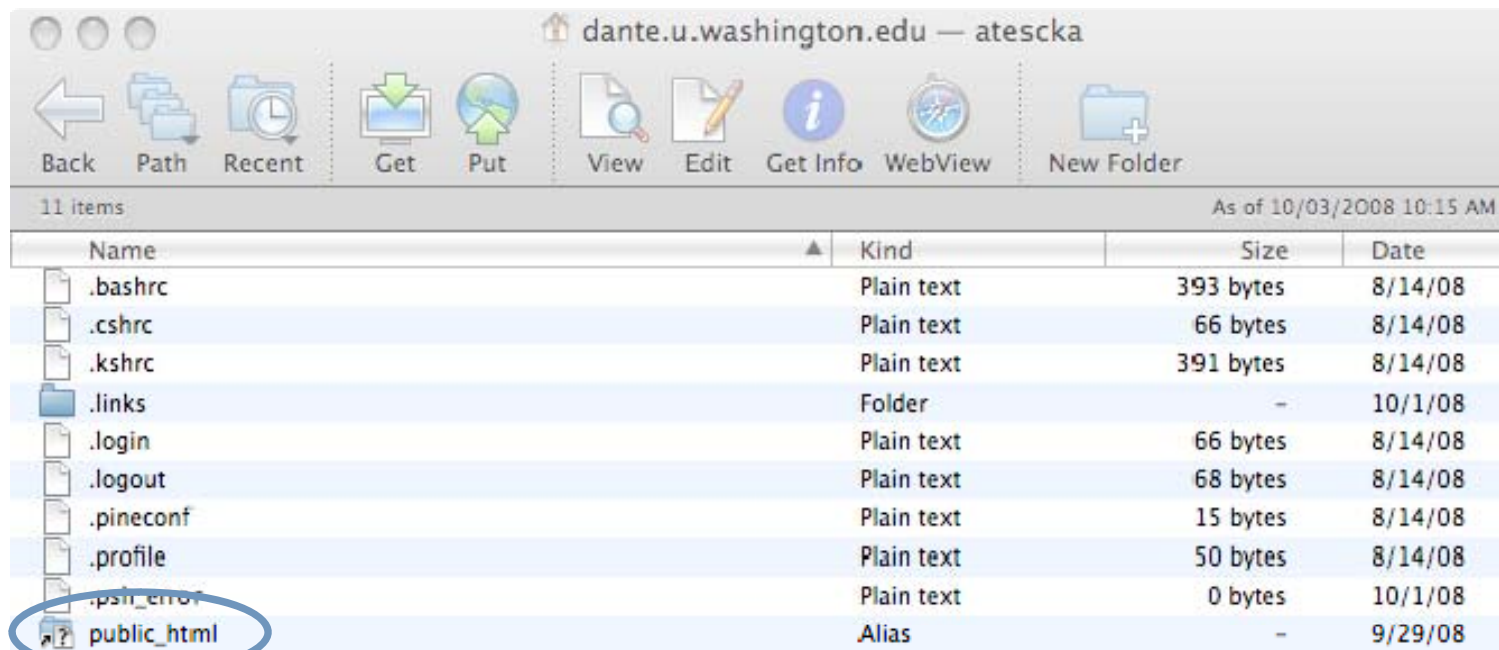
- TextWrangler

- Click on the "Utility" icon on the desktop and find Text Wrangler on the menu that pops up. Click on its icon.
- Select **File** from the menu (top left corner) and then click on **Open**.
- Click on desktop (or wherever the file is saved) on the left pane and you will see your file on the right pane.
- Select your file and hit **Open**.
- Make the additions and save your file (**File** > **Save**).



# Step 6

- Upload your file to Dante
  - Drag your file back into your folder on FETCH inside public\_html.
