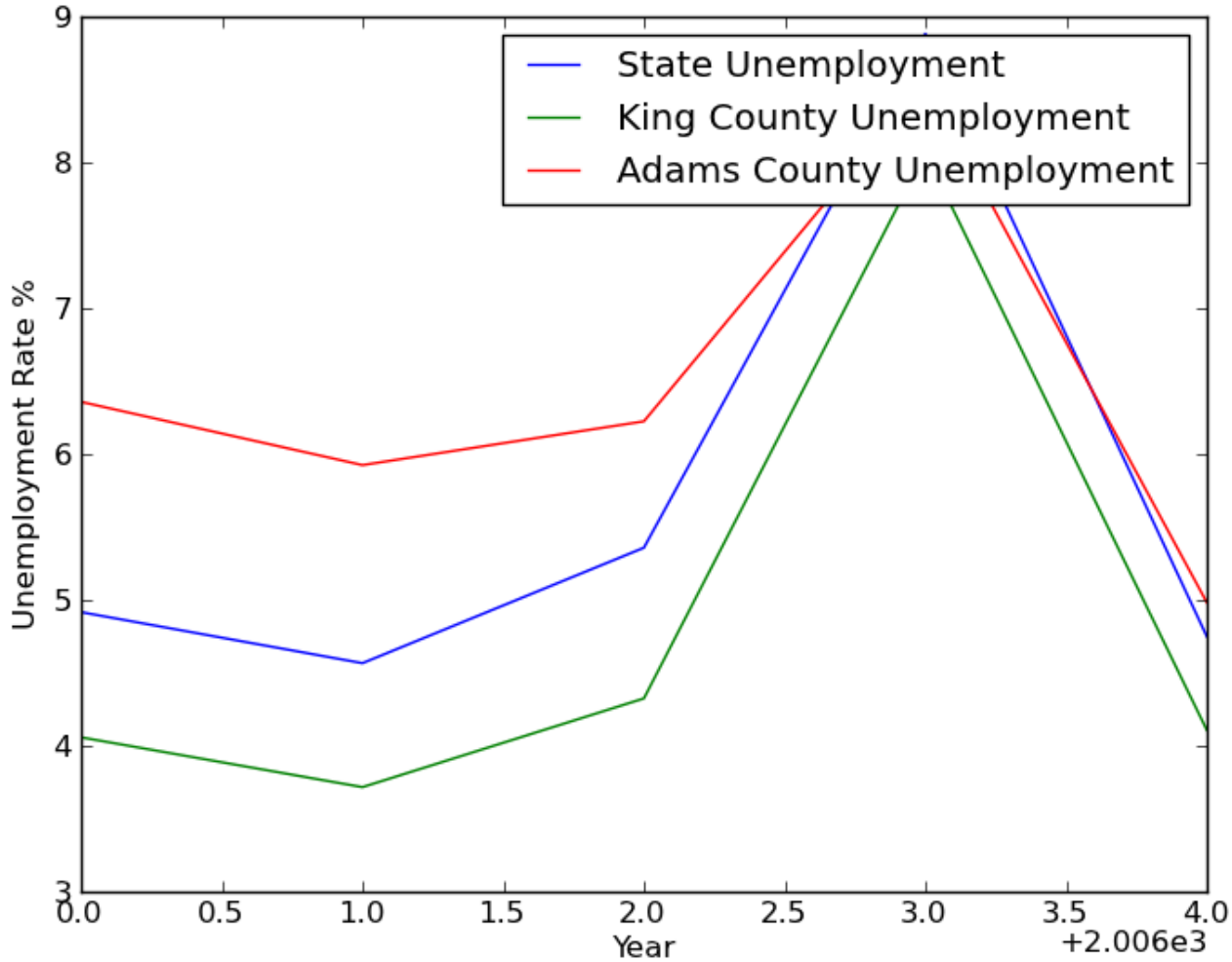

- Adams County population density of 10/mi²
- Higher occupancy change % for higher unemployment change
