	How do you “seed” to a random number generator? How would I go about using that to check if my output is correct?	<p>The Random class has a constructor that takes an int value as a seed. But the Random objects are automatically seeded, so you don’t need to do that.</p> <p>For the homework, the logs are all done with the number to be guessed set to 42. So just do that manually and test your code.</p>
	<p>Is it possible to return more than one value from a method?</p> <p>Are we allowed to use objects for assignment 5?</p>	<p>No. The Java solution would be to return an object and objects can have multiple data values inside them.</p> <p>You are not allowed to define your own objects for homework 5.</p>
