Ok thank you!	<p>Yes, you can have as many DrawingPanel objects as you want and you can give different drawing commands to the different panels. In a case like that you'd want to have variables with names like g1, g2, and g3 to distinguish between the different Graphics objects for the different panels. Each has its own Graphics object.</p> <p>Overlaying wouldn't be easy with two separate panel objects, but I can see how you might want two different views of something.</p>
