Sample Solution to Written Questions

1. The 5th line of code (`n3 = &n2;`) has a type error. The type of `n3` is `double*` (pointer to double), while the expression `&n2` is a pointer to a pointer to double (`double**`).
2. Similar to question 1: the last line of code attempts to assign a value of `int**` to a pointer of type `int*`.
3. Output is:

```
Number is: 10
Hello
Almost done...
Number is: 3
Hello
```
