**0. vowelCount**

Write a JavaScript function name `vowelCount` that accepts a `string` and returns the number of vowels it contains.

For example, the call of `vowelCount("kookaburra")` should return 5 (two o's, two a's, and one u). If passed a `string` without any vowels (such as an empty string, "01234", or "sky"), 0 should be returned.
