1. Consider the following webpage outline (left) and corresponding body HTML (right):



With these two different page elements, we can accomplish quite a few different things with JS! Now consider the following possible scenarios and fill in the tables (A is given as an example):

A. When the window is loaded, log a message "window loaded!" in the console.

Source(s)	Event(s)	Response(s)	Output/Elements changed
window	page load	message logged	console output of "window loaded!"

B. When the button is clicked, change text of #msg to "You clicked the button!"

Source(s)	Event	Response	Output/Elements changed
#btn button	click	change text of #msg	#msg paragraph

C. When the mouse moves over the #msg paragraph, change its text to "You moved the mouse over me!"

Source(s)	Event	Response	Output/Elements changed
#msg paragraph	mouseover	change text of #msg	#msg paragraph
