But its implementation is concerning for various reasons (e.g. relating to security, appropriate use of PHP/SQL, error-handling, etc.). What are some things you can identify as concerns, and how might you fix them using what we've learned about PHP/SQL so far?

    $db = getPDO(); # assume defined in common.php

    $todo = $_GET["todo-name"];
    $author = $_GET["author"];
    $todo_type = $_GET["type"];
    $db->query("INSERT INTO Todos (todo, author, type)
                VALUES ('{$todo}', '{$author}', '{$todo_type}')");
    header("Content-type: text/plain");
    echo "Added {$todo} to {$author}'s Todo List!\n";
