

Week 7 Section QuickCheck

Write a function named `greeting` that accepts two string parameters, `$first` and `$last`, representing a first name and a last name, respectively. Your function should return a greeting message based on these values in the following format:

```
Hello, <First> <L>.!
```

Where `<First>` is the titlecased form of the first string parameter (only the first letter is capitalized) and `<L>` is the capitalized initial for the last name. If the second parameter is `" "`, the message should instead be in the format:

```
Hello, <First>!. 
```

Examples:

```
greeting("Ash", "Ketchum");    # should return "Hello, Ash K.!"
greeting("Mowgli", "");        # should return "Hello, Mowgli!"
```

You may assume `$first` is a non-empty string. We have started the function for you (fill in the parameters and function body):

```
function greeting(                ) {
```

```
}
```
