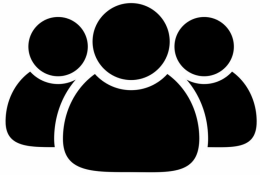
# Professor Meeting Report Discussion

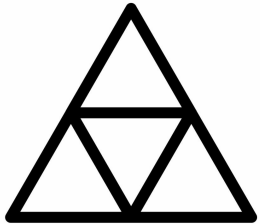

# Presentation Tips



## Think about who your audience is

- Consider what your audience knows / doesn't know



## Less is more

- Keep text clear and concise
- Use simple presentation designs and structures



## Utilize visuals

- Provide different ways to engage your audience



## Pace yourself

- Helps if you practice :)
