








#### Motivation


 Motivation is undoubtedly the single greatest influence on how well people perform. Most productivity studies have found that motivation has a stronger influence on productivity than any other factor. (Boehm 1981)

## Top five motivation factors

- Achievement
- Ownership
- Goal setting
- Possibility for Growth
- Work itself
  - Skill variety
  - Task identity
  - Task significance
  - Autonomy
  - Job feedback



## Top five motivation factors

- Opportunity to focus on the work itself
  - Reduce administration
- Remove obstacles
- Personal life
- Technical-supervision opportunity
  - Assign each developer to be technical lead for some particular product area



# How not to manage: Morale killers (McConnell)

- Management manipulation
- Excessive scheduling pressure
- Lack of appreciation for team member's efforts
- Inappropriate involvement of technically inept
- Not involving team members in decisions that affect
- Productivity barriers
- Low quality
- Heavy handed motivation campaigns
- Frequent changes in direction
