The Development System?

Definition - The *development system* is the collection of people, processes and tools that together produce the system under development.

- >The development system is itself a system,
- It has functions, and attributes.
- It is amenable to analysis, and deliberate design.

Software Engineerign is studying this system.

The tool chain is a big part of it.



The Development System
