

The questions below are the outline for a short essay paper. You are to write this on your own – I'm interested in your individual analysis of your project to date, not a group consensus.

Your essay should be one page long. It can extend over that by a paragraph or two, but the absolute maximum is two pages. A page is defined to be text written in 12 point type, with approximately one inch margins, single spaced.

The grading for these questions will be:

1. Did you answer the question directly with a response that makes sense?
2. Did you provide reasonable fact-based support for why you think this is a valid answer?

There will be an online turn-in link for this on the class calendar page. This paper is due next Thursday night February 9 before 11:59PM.

Provide an answer for each of the following numbered sections.

1. After final delivery, what is likely to be the most successful part of your team's project? Why?
2. What is the greatest risk item for your project? In other words, in the end, which area of the project is most likely to have caused problems that prevent successful delivery and adoption of the intended product? Why is this a high-risk item?
3. You identified reasons for the problem in question 2. What actions would reduce the risk associated with this item? Can you correlate this risk item with those discussed in McConnell? What does he suggest be done for this issue?
