The Problem and Motivation

- Bug fixes often aren't isolated in commits
 - Refactorings and other code changes
- Problem when revisiting code or others try to understand fix
 - Focus on what fixed the bug
- Potentially unaware of what fixed bug
 - Could be combination of changes across multiple files

Current Solutions

Know Minimum Bug Fix

- Git add -patch
 - o Interactively stage parts of a file
- Git rebase -i
 - Split old commits into multiple

Don't Know Minimum Bug Fix

Manually remove lines

Our Approach

- 1. Git pre-commit hook
- 2. 2 phase detection and execution
 - Remove refactored lines
 - Remove subsets of changed lines until it finds the largest subset of lines it can remove without causing the test to fail.
- 3. Commit bug fix
- 4. Commit remaining code
