# The Problem and Motivation

- Bug fixes often aren't isolated in commits
  - Refactorings and other code changes
- Problem when revisiting code or others try to understand fix
  - Focus on what fixed the bug
- Potentially unaware of what fixed bug
  - Could be combination of changes across multiple files



# Current Solutions

## Know Minimum Bug Fix

- `Git add -patch`
  - Interactively stage parts of a file
- `Git rebase -i`
  - Split old commits into multiple

## Don't Know Minimum Bug Fix

- Manually remove lines

# Our Approach

1. Git pre-commit hook
2. 2 phase detection and execution
  - Remove refactored lines
  - Remove subsets of changed lines until it finds the largest subset of lines it can remove without causing the test to fail.
3. Commit bug fix
4. Commit remaining code
