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
Motivation

Test assertions: important but time-consuming

Current Solution and Its Limitations

Toradocu

- → Translate Java comments into test assertions
- Matching texts in the Javadoc comments with method and variable names
- → Still need to improve in correctness
- → Only detect @tagged descriptions for exceptional behaviors

Our Tool [EXTENSION]

- → Looking at the docs of methods and variables for text-matching
- → Detect descriptions in natural language for exceptional behaviors
- → Better correctness
