This option guides you through the basic configurations necessary for creating a new virtual machine.


Use default settings to create a virtual machine

You can automatically create a .vmc file with default settings. The resulting virtual machine will not have a virtual hard disk associated with it, so you will have to select one using the Settings dialog.



Virtual Hard Disk Options

The Linked to a hard disk option is advanced.



Select a virtual hard disk option:

Dynamically expanding (Recommended)

Fixed size


This virtual hard disk uses a fixed amount of space regardless of the amount of data stored on it. Its default size is the maximum amount of space available on your physical hard disk.

Differencing

This virtual hard disk is based on an existing virtual hard disk configuration. Only changes are stored to the differencing virtual hard disk.

Linked to a hard disk (Advanced)

This virtual hard disk links to a hard disk on the physical computer.
