audience.**

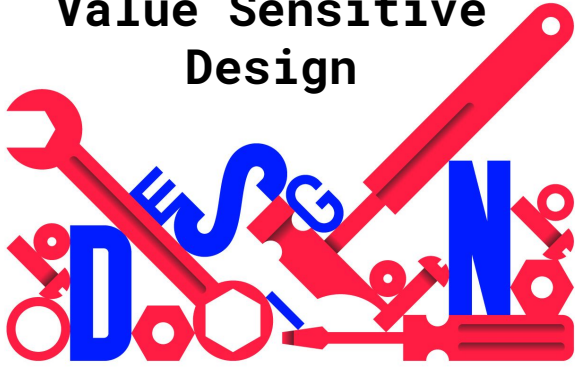
