You should upload a presentation of your project; we watch your presentation, and give feedback to you so you can incorporate in your final project report. You can find detailed instructions on how to make and upload your presentations [here](#).

- Please record a 3-5 minute presentation. Your slide(s) should be played continuously during this time.
  - Your presentation should include motivation, problem definition, approach, data, results, and findings (analyses).
  - Your presentation can be either in slide show (containing multiple slides) or poster format (single slide containing all the important information). Either choice should continuously play.
