

# **CSEP 590E: Practical Aspects of Modern Cryptography**

Final Project Proposals

In lieu of a final exam, each student will be expected to do a final project. The project should consist of an in-depth exploration of some topic covered in or related to the class. Projects will consist of a written report of roughly 5-7 pages due at the beginning of finals week (December 12) and an oral presentation of roughly 5-7 minutes to be given during finals week.

Students should submit proposals by November 8. Proposals need only be a paragraph or two and outline the scope of the proposed project. Feedback will be provided and an agreement on the scope of each project should be concluded by November 15 at the latest.
